XLP stands for "The eXcel Project" – a registered charity at the cutting edge of urban youth work in the UK. XLP was started in Peckham, South London, in 1996 after a stabbing in a school playground. Today XLP serves young people in schools and communities across seven of London's poorest boroughs (Southwark, Lewisham, Bexley, Newham, Tower Hamlets, Greenwich, Islington and Camden).

Every month, XLP operates in over 40 schools providing PSHE/Citizenship lessons, assemblies, lunchtime clubs, music, drama, RE and reading support. Our teams host over 65 after-school clubs in local communities and aboard our double-decker bus facility every month. XLP's Arts team organises an annual Arts Showcase programme, and runs a new mobile recording studio. XLP also organises an anti-gun and knife presentation called 'Gunzdown'. Overall, XLP has built up a wealth of experience and continually strives to introduce innovative and wide-reaching youth initiatives with tangible outcomes.
